
Lord Jesus, Divine Teacher, thank you for the privilege of sharing your Word of Life with the children in my care.

HOW DOES THE CATECHIST FORMATION PROGRAM WORK?

INITIAL FORMATION

PART 1: PROVISIONAL ACCREDITATION

Initial Formation Course

8 sessions consisting of Adult Faith Formation and Religious Education Teaching Skills.

PART 2: FULL ACCREDITATION

- Scripture in the Classroom (four sessions) and
- Theology in the Classroom (four sessions)

Part 1 must be completed before enrolling for Part 2.

Requirements

- Endorsement of Parish Priest
- Participants must complete all sessions.

On completion of Parts 1 and 2 participants will be commissioned as Catechists (see flow chart page 9).

ONGOING FORMATION

CATECHIST CERTIFICATES I AND II

In order to be accredited with Certificate I or II Catechists must complete one unit in each of the following:

- Theology
- Scripture
- Religious Education
- Spirituality

A unit normally consists of 2 days, and a half-unit is 1 day.

Units can be accredited towards either:



GOSPEL OF MATTHEW

Matthew's Gospel was written for Jews who found themselves in transition from their Jewish heritage to being members of the Christian community. Matthew brings a reassuring voice to times of change.

Matthew's portrait of Jesus shows him frequently locked in battle with the pharisees. They protect their heritage and their power by strict adherence to the law and are unable to accept Jesus and his kingdom of mercy.

Matthew's gospel is the most Jewish of the Gospels. It is the Gospel most closely linked to the Old Testament and the prophecies of the coming Messiah.

UNDERSTANDING LITURGY

THE LIFE OF ST PETER



St Peter, along with his brother Andrew were the first disciples chosen by Jesus to follow him.


THE BEATITUDES

On a hill by Lake Galilee, Jesus welcomes all those who come to him bewildered by suffering and oppressed by the powerful. Jesus declares them blessed, affirming the goodness they carry within. He delivers a new teaching that fulfills the Law and the Prophets.

In the Beatitudes (Matthew 5 and Luke 6) Jesus offers a view of life that is against the flow but that gives humanity a glimpse of the coming kingdom.

Pope Francis writes that the Beatitudes are a 'self-portrait' of Jesus and an 'identity card' for Christians (Rejoice and Be Glad 63).

The Antiphons give us names by which we may know and recognise the God humanity has always longed for and continues to need today.


