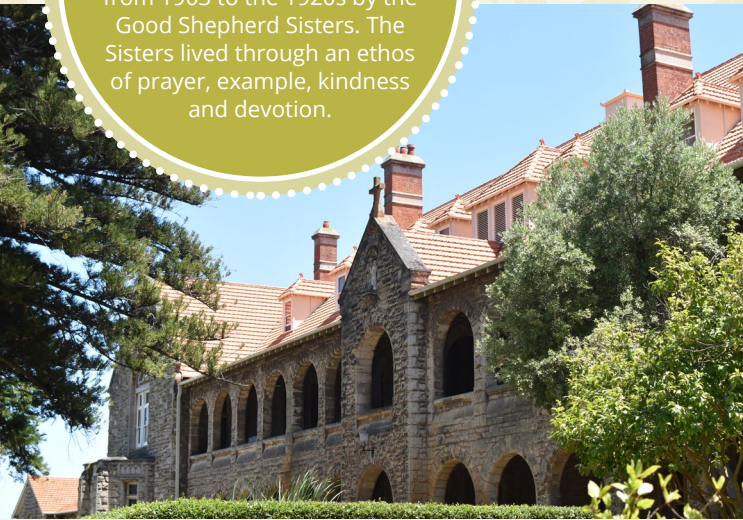

The Chapel and grounds are available for weddings only* on Saturdays and Sundays at the following times:

No weekday bookings are available. To ensure all weddings run smoothly these two hour time slots must be strictly adhered to. Please ensure your guests arrive and your ceremony starts at the times stated.

Celebration

The celebrant must be a Catholic priest. Please note that the Catholic Education Office does not have a resident priest and it is your responsibility to arrange a priest to officiate at your wedding.

To be married in the Chapel both parties must be free to marry and at least one party must be Catholic.

Booking fee

The fee includes the hire of the building, fresh flowers for the altar and the use of an electric keyboard, pipe organ#, CD or MP3 player.

If you arrange guest singers or musicians they are required to bring their own sound equipment.

To book the Chapel please contact the receptionist at the Catholic Education Office on 9380 1800 during office hours. Once a tentative booking is made you will be required to return the signed application form and booking fee within four weeks to confirm your booking.
